An Act to incorporate the Institute of Environmental Professionals, Sri Lanka

WHEREAS an Institute called and known as the "Institute of Environmental Professionals, Sri Lanka" has heretofore been established in Sri Lanka for the purpose of effectually carrying out its objects and transacting all matters connected with the said Institute according to the rules agreed to by its members:

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS the said Institute has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted the several objects and matters for which it was established and has applied to be incorporated and it will be for the public advantage to grant the said application:

BE it therefore, enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Institute of Environmental Professionals, Sri Lanka (Incorporation) Act, No. 1 of 2020.

Short title.

2. From and after the date of commencement of this Act, such and so many persons as now are members of the Institute of Environmental Professionals, Sri Lanka (hereinafter referred to as the "Institute") and shall hereafter be admitted as members of the body corporate hereby constituted shall have perpetual succession under the name and style of the "Institute of Environmental Professionals, Sri Lanka" (hereinafter referred to as the "body corporate"), and by that name may sue and be sued with full power and authority to have, and use a common seal and to alter the same at its pleasure.

Incorporation of Institute of Environmental Professionals, Sri Lanka. 2 Institute of Environmental Professionals, Sri Lanka (Incorporation) Act, No. 1 of 2020

General objects of the body corporate.

- **3.** The general objects for which the body corporate is constituted are hereby declared to be—
 - (a) to raise and uphold the dignity and reputation of environmental professionals in Sri Lanka;
 - (b) to disseminate environmental knowledge among the public;
 - (c) to foster communication between environmental professionals;
 - (d) to encourage and promote interdisciplinary research with a view of increasing scientific understanding of environmental issues;
 - (e) to provide an enabling platform to discuss environmental and development related issues;
 - (f) to encourage and to publish environmental publications; and
 - (g) to assist any, Ministry or Department of the Government or any Provincial Council pursuant to a written request made by such, Ministry or Department of the Government or any Provincial Council—
 - (i) to conserve and enhance the natural and physical environment of Sri Lanka;
 - (ii) to facilitate training programmes for environmental scientists and persons engaged in the conservation of the environment.

- **4.** The objects of the body corporate shall be carried out in such manner so as not to create any conflict between the work of the body corporate and any work being carried out simultaneously by any Ministry or Department of the Government or of any Provincial Council.
- Body corporate to ensure no conflict with work of Ministry or Department of the Government or Province.
- 5. (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the management and administration of the affairs of the body corporate shall be carried out by a Governing Council (hereinafter referred to as the "Council") consisting of such number of office bearers as may be specified by the rules made under section 7.
- Management of affairs of the body corporate.
- (2) (a) The Council of the Institute that holds office on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act shall function as an Interim Council of the body corporate until the first Council is appointed or elected in the manner provided for by rules made under section 7.
- (b) Subject to the provisions of section 7, the Interim Council shall have the power to make rules for the interim administration of the body corporate and for election or appointment of the members of the first Council of the body corporate, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any written law.
- (c) Any decision of the Interim Council shall be taken by the majority of its members present at any meeting.
- (d) The first Council of the body corporate shall be appointed or elected within one year of the date of commencement of this Act.
- (3) (a) Every office bearer of the Council including the patrons and advisors, shall be appointed or elected for a period of one year and any such office bearer, patron or advisor shall be eligible for re-appointment or re-election after the lapse of the said period of one year.

- (b) In the event of a vacancy occurring due to the death, resignation, incapacity or removal from office of an office bearer, the Council shall having regard to the rules of the body corporate, elect or appoint a person to fill such vacancy.
- (c) The person elected or appointed under paragraph (b) shall hold office only for the unexpired portion of the term of office of the member whom he succeeds.

Powers of the body corporate.

- **6.** Subject to the provisions of this Act and any other written law, the body corporate shall have the power to do, perform and execute all such acts as are necessary to achieve the objects of the body corporate, including the power -
 - (a) to purchase, rent, construct and renovate lands or buildings which may be required for the purposes of the body corporate and to deal with or dispose of the same as may be deemed expedient with a view to promoting the objects of the body corporate;
 - (b) enter into and perform or carry out, whether directly or through any officer or agent authorized in that behalf by the body corporate, all such contracts or agreements as may be necessary for the attainment of the objects or the exercise of the powers of the body corporate;
 - (c) to borrow or raise funds with or without securities and to receive grants, gifts or donations in cash or kind:

Provided that, the Council shall obtain the prior written approval of the Department of External Resources of the Minister assigned the subject of Finance in respect of all foreign grants, gifts or donations made to the body corporate;

- (d) to make, draw, accept, discount, endorse, negotiate, buy, sell and issue bills of exchange, cheques, promissory notes and other negotiable instruments and to open, operate, maintain and close accounts in any bank;
- (e) to invest any funds that are not immediately required for the purposes of the body corporate, in such manner as the Council may determine;
- (f) to undertake, accept, execute, perform and administer any lawful trust or any real or personal property with a view to promoting the objects of the body corporate;
- (g) to appoint, employ, dismiss or terminate the services of officers and servants of the body corporate and exercise disciplinary control over them and to pay them such salaries, allowances and gratuities as may be determined by the body corporate;
- (h) to organize lectures, seminars and conferences with a view to promoting the objectives of the body corporate;
- (i) to liaise and co-ordinate with other local and foreign institutions having similar objects to that of the boby corporate; and
- (*j*) to train officers and servants of the body corporate in Sri Lanka or abroad for the purposes of the body corporate.
- 7. (1) It shall be lawful for the body corporate, from time to time, at any general meeting of the body corporate and by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the members

present and voting, to make rules, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any other written law, for all or any of the following matters:—

- (a) the classification of membership, admission, withdrawal, expulsion or resignation of members and fees payable by the members;
- (b) the election of office bearers of the Council or vacation of or removal from office of office bearers and the powers, duties and functions of the office bearers;
- (c) the terms and conditions of appointment, powers, functions and duties of various officers, and servants of the body corporate;
- (d) the procedure to be followed for the summoning and holding of meetings of the Council, notices and agenda of such meetings, the quorum and the conduct of business thereat;
- (e) the qualifications and disqualifications to be a member of the Council and the body corporate;
- (f) the administration and management of the property of the body corporate; and
- (g) generally the management of the affairs of the body corporate and the accomplishment of its' objects and dissolution of the body corporate.
- (2) Any rule made by the body corporate may be amended, altered, added to or rescinde at a like meeting and in like manner, as a rule made under subsection (1) of this section.

- (3) The rules made under subsection (1) shall be published in the *Gazette* within three months and shall come into effect on the date thereof.
- (4) The members of the body corporate shall at all times be subject to the rules of the body corporate.
- **8.** The Council shall maintain a register of members in which name, address and other essential details of the members shall be inscribed.

Register of members.

9. (1) The body corporate shall have its own Fund.

Fund of the body corporate.

- (2) All moneys received by way of gift, bequest, donation, subscription, contribution, fees or grant for and on account of the body corporate shall be deposited in one or more banks approved by the Council to the credit of the body corporate subject to the provisions of section 6(c).
- (3) There shall be paid out of the Fund, all such sums of money as are required to defray any expenditure incurred by the body corporate in the exercise, performance and discharge of its powers, duties and functions under the Act.
- **10.** (1) The financial year of the body corporate shall be the calendar year.

Accounts and Auditing.

- (2) The body corporate shall cause proper accounts to be kept of its income and expenditure, assets and liabilities and all other transactions of the body corporate.
- (3) The accounts of the body corporate shall be audited anually by the Auditor-General or a qualified auditor appointed by the Auditor General in terms of provisions of Article 154 of the Constitution.

- (4) For the purposes of this section "qualified auditor" means—
 - (a) an individual who being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka, or of any other institute established by law, possesses a certificate to practice as an Accountant issued by the Council of such Institute; or
 - (b) a firm of Accountants, each of the resident partners of which, being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka or of any other Institute established by law, possesses a certificate to practice as an Accountant issued by the Council of such Institute.

Annual Report.

- 11. (1) The Council shall prepare a report of the activities of the body corporate for each financial year and submit such report together with the audited statement of accounts to the Secretary of the Ministry of the Minister to whom the subject of Environment is assigned in terms of Articles 43 and 44 of the Constitution and to the Registrar of Voluntary Social Services Organizations appointed under the Voluntary Social Services Organizations (Registration and Supervision) Act, No. 31 of 1980 before the expiration of six months of the year succeeding the year to which such report relates.
- (2) A separate account relating to the foreign and local moneys received by the body corporate during the financial year shall be attached to the report referred to in subsection (1).

Debts due by and payable to the Institute.

12. All debts and liabilities of the Institute existing on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act, shall be paid by the body corporate hereby constituted and all debts due to and subscriptions and contributions payable to the Institute on that day shall be paid to the body corporate for the purposes of this Act.

13. Subject to the provisions of this Act, the body corporate shall be able and capable in law to take and hold any property, movable or immovable, which may become vested in it by virtue of any purchase, grant, gift, testamentary disposition or otherwise, and all such property shall be held by the body corporate for the purpose of this Act and subject to the rules of the body corporate made under section 7, with power to sell, mortgage, lease, exchange, or otherwise dispose of the same.

Body corporate may hold property movable and immovable.

14. The moneys and property of the body corporate however derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the body corporate and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or profit to the members of the body corporate.

Application of moneys and property.

15. (1) The seal of the body corporate shall not be affixed to any instrument whatsoever, except in the presence of two members of the Council who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence and such signing shall be independent of the signing of any person as a witness.

Seal of the body corporate.

- (2) The seal of the body corporate shall be in the custody of an office bearer of the Council as may be decided by the Council.
- 16. (1) If upon the dissolution of the body corporate there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, such property shall not be distributed among the members of the body corporate, but shall be given or transferred to any other institution having objects similar to those of the body corporate, and which is by the rules thereof, prohibited from distributing any income or property among its members.

Property remaining on dissolution.

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1) the appropriate institution shall be determined by the members of the body corporate immediately before the dissolution at a general meeting by the majority of votes of the members present.

Saving of the rights of the Republic.

17. Nothing in this Act contained shall prejudice or affect the rights of the Republic or of any body politic or corporate.

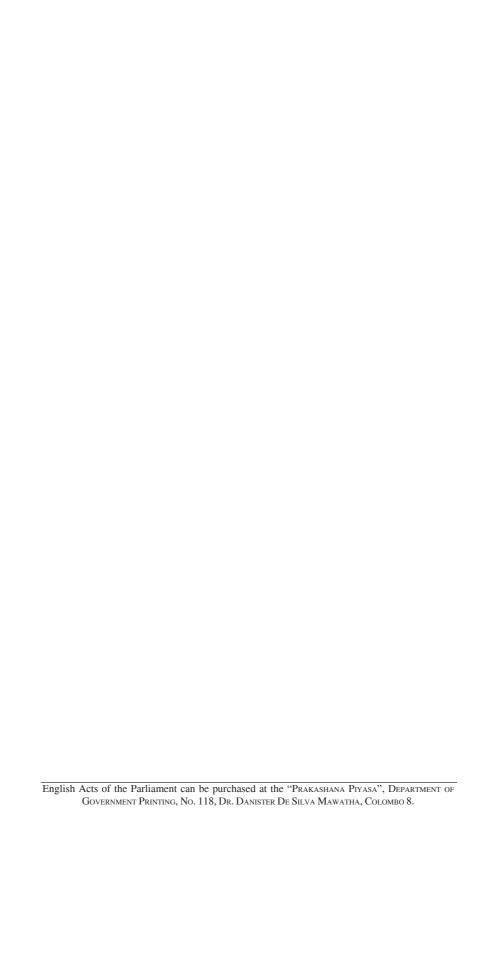

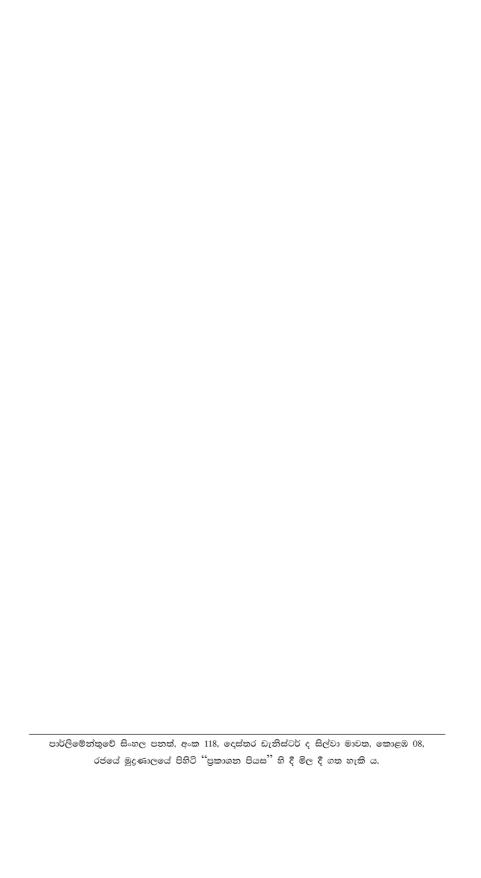

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE SERVICE OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2020; TO AUTHORIZE THE RAISING OF LOANS IN OR OUTSIDE SRI LANKA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUCH SERVICE; TO MAKE FINANCIAL PROVISION IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN ACTIVITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT DURING THAT FINANCIAL YEAR; TO ENABLE THE PAYMENT BY WAY OF ADVANCES OUT OF THE Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the DISPOSAL OF THE GOVERNMENT, OF MONEYS REQUIRED DURING THAT FINANCIAL YEAR FOR EXPENDITURE ON SUCH ACTIVITIES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE REFUND OF SUCH MONEYS TO THE CONSOLIDATED FUND AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH OR INCIDENTAL THERETO.

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, Short title. No. 6 of 2020.
- (1) Without prejudice to anything in any other Appropriation written law authorizing any expenditure and subject to the for financial year provisions of subsection (4) of this section, the expenditure 2020. of the Government which is estimated to be rupees two thousand seven hundred eighteen billion twenty two million for the service of the period beginning on January 1, 2020 and ending on December 31, 2020 (in this Act referred to as the "financial year 2020"), shall be met -
 - (a) from payments which are hereby authorized to be made out of the Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government: and

(b) from borrowing made in the financial year 2020 which are hereby authorized in terms of relevant laws for moneys to be raised whether in or outside Sri Lanka, for and on behalf of the Government, provided that the balance outstanding of such borrowing at any given time during the financial year 2020 or at the end of the financial year 2020 shall not exceed rupees two thousand eight hundred thirty billion and the details of such loans shall be incorporated in the Final Budget Position Report which is required to be tabled in Parliament under section 13 of the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No. 3 of 2003:

Provided that, the difference between the total short-term borrowing raised during the financial year 2020 and the total settlement of short-term borrowing made during the financial year 2020 shall only be considered in deciding the volume of short-term borrowing for the purposes of calculating the borrowing made during the financial year 2020 as specified in this section.

- (2) The sum of rupees two thousand seven hundred eighteen billion twenty two million referred to in subsection (1), may be expended as specified in the First Schedule to this Act.
- (3) The provisions of subsection (1) shall have effect without prejudice to the provisions of any other written law, authorizing the raising of loans for and on behalf of the Government.
- (4) The estimated expenditure of the Government authorized by laws to be charged on the Consolidated Fund, shall be rupees two thousand billion one hundred thirty three million for the service of the period beginning on January 1, 2020 and ending on December 31, 2020. The Expenditure Heads and the laws under which such expenditure is authorized to be made, are as specified in the Second Schedule to this Act.

- 3. (1) The receipts of the Government during the financial year 2020, from each activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act shall be credited to the account of such activity, but the aggregate of receipts so credited shall not be less than the minimum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column III of that Schedule. The net surplus, if any, of such activity, shall be paid to the Consolidated Fund before the expiry of six months after the close of the financial year 2020.
- Financial provisions in respect of certain activities of the Government for the financial year 2020.
- (2) For the purpose of determining the net surplus under subsection (1), the following charges shall be set off against the revenue of each activity:-
 - (a) the working, establishment and other expenses of the activity, whether paid or accrued, properly chargeable to the revenue of the activity; and
 - (b) provision to cover the depreciation of the movable and immovable property of the activity.
- (3) The expenditure incurred by the Government during the financial year 2020 on each activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act, shall be paid out of the receipts of the Government from such activity during that financial year, but such expenditure shall not exceed the maximum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that Schedule.
- (4) The debit balance outstanding at the end of the financial year 2020 of any activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act, shall not exceed the maximum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column IV of that Schedule and the total liabilities of that activity at the end of that financial year, shall not exceed the maximum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column V of that Schedule.

Payment from the Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government, of advances for expenditure on the activities referred to in section 3, during the financial year 2020.

- 4. Whenever at any time during the financial year 2020, the receipts of the Government from any activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act are insufficient to meet the expenditure incurred by the Government on such activity, the Minister may, from time to time, by Order, direct that such sums as he may deem necessary to meet such expenditure shall be payable by way of advances, out of the Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government, so however that the aggregate of the sums so advanced shall not exceed the maximum limit of expenditure specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that Schedule. Any sum so advanced in respect of such activity shall be refunded to the Consolidated Fund in such manner, as the Minister may by Order direct.
- Power to transfer unexpended moneys allocated to Recurrent Expenditure, to another allocation within the same Programme or to another Programme under the same Head of Expenditure.
- 5. (1) Any moneys which by virtue of the provisions of the First Schedule to this Act, have been allocated to Recurrent Expenditure under any Programme appearing under any Head specified in that Schedule, but have not been expended or are not likely to be expended, may be transferred to the allocation of Capital Expenditure within that Programme or to the allocation of Recurrent Expenditure or Capital Expenditure under any other Programme within that Head, by Order of the Secretary to the Treasury or by Order either of a Deputy Secretary to the Treasury or the Director General of the National Budget Department, who may be authorized in that behalf by the Secretary to the Treasury.
- (2) No moneys allocated to Capital Expenditure under any Programme appearing under any Head specified in the First Schedule to this Act, shall be transferred out of that Programme or to any allocation of Recurrent Expenditure of that Programme.

- (1) Any money allocated to Recurrent Expenditure or Capital Expenditure under the "Development Activities" Programme appearing under the Head "Department of National Budget" specified in the First Schedule, may be transferred subject to guidelines stipulated in Budget Estimates approved by Parliament for the relevant year, to any other Programme under any other Head in that Schedule, by Order of the Secretary to the Treasury or by Order either of a Deputy Secretary to the Treasury or the Director General of the National Budget Department, who may be authorized in that behalf by the Secretary to the Treasury. The money so transferred shall be deemed to be a supplementary allocation made to the particular Ministry, and a report containing the amount of money so transferred and the reasons for the transfer, shall be submitted to Parliament within two months of the date of the said transfer.
- Money allocated to the "Development Activities" Programme may be transferred to any other Programme under any other Head.
- (2) Details of all transfers made under subsection (1), including the reasons for such transfers, shall be incorporated in the reports relating to the Government's fiscal performance, which are required to be tabled in Parliament under the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No.3 of 2003.
 - 7. Where the Minister is satisfied-
 - (a) that receipts from taxes and other sources will be less than the amounts anticipated to finance authorized expenditure; or
 - expenditure previously authorized.

Power of Minister to limit

(b) that amounts originally appropriated for a particular purpose or purposes are no longer required,

he may with the approval of the Government, withdraw in whole or in part any amounts previously released for expenditure under the authority of a warrant issued by him, from the Consolidated Fund or from any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government, to meet any authorized expenditure and the details of all such withdrawals shall be incorporated in the Final Budget Position Report which is required to be tabled in Parliament under section 13 of the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No. 3 of 2003.

Appropriation Act, No. 6 of 2020

Power of Minister to vary the maximum and minimum limits specified in the Third Schedule to this Act. 6

- **8.** (1) The Minister with the approval of the Government may, on or before May 31, 2021, by Order, vary or alter-
 - (a) any of the maximum limits specified in Column II, Column IV and Column V; and
 - (b) the minimum limits specified in Column III,

of the Third Schedule to this Act.

- (2) No Order made under subsection (1) shall have effect, unless it has been approved by Parliament by Resolution.
- (3) Any Order made under subsection (1) shall, if so expressed therein, be deemed to have had effect from such date prior to the date of making such Order, as may be specified therein.

Power of Parliament to amend the Third Schedule to this Act.

- **9.** Parliament may by Resolution amend the Third Schedule to this Act, by adding to the appropriate Columns of that Schedule any activity and providing for -
 - (a) all or any of the maximum limits relating to such activity;
 - (b) the minimum limit relating to such activity.

10. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Resolution passed by Parliament under paragraph (2) of Article 150 of the Constitution on October 23, 2019, making financial provision for expenditure for the period commencing on January 1, 2020 and ending on April 30, 2020 and the Resolution passed by Parliament under paragraph (2) of Article 150 of the Constitution on August 28, 2020, making financial provisions for expenditure for the period commencing on September 1, 2020 and ending on December 31, 2020:-

Certain expenditure and advances made under Resolutions passed under Article 150(2) of the Constitution deemed to be included in the First Schedule, Second Schedule and Third Schedule to this Act.

- (a) all such sums of money which have been expended during the respective periods, out of the moneys allocated by such Resolutions to any Programme appearing under any Head specified in the First Schedule to such Resolutions and any moneys which have not been expended on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act shall for all purposes be deemed to be included in the moneys allocated to the corresponding Programme appearing under the corresponding Head, as specified in the First Schedule to this Act;
- (b) all such sums of money which have been expended during the respective periods, out of the moneys allocated by such Resolutions to any Programme appearing under any Head specified in the Second Schedule to such Resolutions, and any moneys which have not been expended on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act shall for all purposes be deemed to be included in the moneys allocated to the corresponding Programme appearing under the corresponding Head, as specified in the Second Schedule to this Act; and
- (c) any such sums paid by way of advances out of the Consolidated Fund during the respective periods, in respect of advance account activities specified in the Third Schedule to such Resolutions, and any moneys which have not been expended on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act shall for all purposes be deemed to be included in the moneys allocated to the corresponding activities specified in the Third Schedule to this Act.

Borrowings made in terms of the Resolutions passed under Article 150(2) of the Constitution deemed to be raised under section 2(1)(b) of this Act.

11. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Resolutions passed by Parliament under paragraph (2) of Article 150 of the Constitution on October 23, 2019 and August 28, 2020 referred to in section 10, making provisions for loans to be raised in terms of relevant laws whether in or outside Sri Lanka, for and on behalf of the Government, proceeds of loans, which have been raised during the respective periods out of the moneys appearing in such Resolutions, shall be deemed for all purposes to have been raised under section 2(1)(b) of this Act.

Expenditure and advances authorized under Article 150(3) of the Constitution to be deemed to be included in the First Schedule and Third Schedule to this Act.

- 12. All such sums of money authorized as financial provisions for public services by the President under paragraph (3) of Article 150 of the Constitution, for a period of three months commencing on March 6, 2020 and for a period of three months commencing on June 1, 2020, and-
 - (a) expended during the respective periods, out of the moneys allocated by such authorizations included as Annexures to the Budget Estimates for the relevant year tabled in Parliament, to any Programme appearing under any Head, specified in the First Schedule to such authorizations, shall for all purposes be deemed to be included in the moneys allocated to the corresponding Heads, as specified in the First and Second Schedules to this Act; and
 - (b) paid by way of advances out of the Consolidated Fund during the respective periods in respect of advance account activities specified in the Second Schedule to such authorizations, shall for all purposes be deemed to be included in the moneys allocated to the corresponding activities specified in the Third Schedule to this Act.

Sinhala text to prevail in case of inconsistency.

13. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall prevail.

An Act to provide for the service of the financial year 2021; to authorize the raising of loans in or outside Sri Lanka, for the purpose of such service; to make financial provision in respect of certain activities of the Government during that financial year; to enable the payment by way of advances out of the Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government, of moneys required during that financial year for expenditure on such activities; to provide for the refund of such moneys to the Consolidated Fund and to make provision for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, No. 7 of 2020.

Short title.

- 2. (1) Without prejudice to anything in any other law authorizing any expenditure and subject to the provisions of subsection (4) of this section, the expenditure of the Government which is estimated to be rupees two thousand eight hundred eighteen billion three hundred ninety million for the service of the period beginning on January 1, 2021 and ending on December 31, 2021 (in this Act referred to as the "financial year 2021"), shall be met –
- Appropriation for financial year, 2021.

(a) from payments which are hereby authorized to be made out of the Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government; and (b) from borrowing made in the financial year 2021 which are hereby authorized in terms of relevant laws for moneys to be raised whether in or outside Sri Lanka, for and on behalf of the Government, provided that the balance outstanding of such borrowing at any given time during the financial year 2021 or at the end of the financial year 2021 shall not exceed rupees two thousand nine hundred ninety seven billion and the details of such loans shall be incorporated in the Final Budget Position Report which is required to be tabled in Parliament under section 13 of the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No. 3 of 2003:

Provided that, the difference between the total short-term borrowing raised during the financial year 2021 and the total settlement of short-term borrowing made during the financial year 2021 shall only be considered in deciding the volume of short-term borrowing for the purposes of calculating the borrowing made during the financial year 2021 as specified in this section.

- (2) The sum of rupees two thousand eight hundred eighteen billion three hundred ninety million referred to in subsection (1), may be expended as specified in the First Schedule to this Act.
- (3) The provisions of subsection (1) shall have effect without prejudice to the provisions of any other written law, authorizing the raising of loans for and on behalf of the Government.
- (4) The estimated expenditure of the Government authorized by laws to be charged on the Consolidated Fund, shall be rupees two thousand two hundred twenty eight billion one hundred forty eight million for the service of the period beginning on January 1, 2021 and ending on December 31, 2021. The expenditure Heads and the laws under which such expenditure is authorized to be made, are as specified in the Second Schedule to this Act.

- 3. (1) The receipts of the Government during the financial year 2021, from each activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act, shall be credited to the account of such activity, but the aggregate of receipts so credited shall not be less than the minimum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column III of that Schedule. The net surplus, if any, of such activity, shall be paid to the Consolidated Fund before the expiry of six months after the close of the financial year 2021.
- Financial provisions in respect of certain activities of the Government for the financial year 2021.
- (2) For the purpose of determining the net surplus under subsection (1), the following charges shall be set off against the revenue of each activity:-
 - (a) the working, establishment and other expenses of the activity, whether paid or accrued, properly chargeable to the revenue of the activity; and
 - (b) provision to cover the depreciation of the movable and immovable property of the activity.
- (3) The expenditure incurred by the Government during the financial year 2021 on each activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act, shall be paid out of the receipts of the Government from such activity during that financial year, but such expenditure shall not exceed the maximum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that Schedule.
- (4) The debit balance outstanding at the end of the financial year 2021, of any activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act, shall not exceed the maximum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column IV of that Schedule and the total liabilities of that activity at the end of that financial year, shall not exceed the maximum limit specified in the corresponding entry in Column V of that Schedule.

Appropriation Act, No. 7 of 2020

Payment from the Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government, of advances for expenditure on the activities referred to in section 3, during the financial year 2021. 4

4. Whenever at any time during the financial year 2021, the receipts of the Government from any activity specified in Column I of the Third Schedule to this Act are insufficient to meet the expenditure incurred by the Government on such activity, the Minister may, from time to time, by Order, direct that such sums as he may deem necessary to meet such expenditure shall be payable by way of advances, out of the Consolidated Fund or any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government, so however that the aggregate of the sums so advanced shall not exceed the maximum limit of expenditure specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that Schedule. Any sum so advanced in respect of such activity shall be refunded to the Consolidated Fund in such manner, as the Minister may by Order direct.

Power to transfer unexpended moneys allocated to Recurrent Expenditure, to another allocation within the same Programme or to another Programme under the same Head of expenditure.

- 5. (1) Any moneys which by virtue of the provisions of the First Schedule to this Act, have been allocated to Recurrent Expenditure under any Programme appearing under any Head specified in that Schedule, but have not been expended or are not likely to be expended, may be transferred to the allocation of Capital Expenditure within that Programme or to the allocation of Recurrent Expenditure or Capital Expenditure under any other Programme within that Head, by Order of the Secretary to the Treasury or by Order either of a Deputy Secretary to the Treasury or the Director General of the National Budget Department, who may be authorized in that behalf by the Secretary to the Treasury.
- (2) No moneys allocated to Capital Expenditure under any Programme appearing under any Head specified in the First Schedule to this Act, shall be transferred out of that Programme or to any allocation of Recurrent Expenditure of that Programme.

- (1) Any money allocated to Recurrent Expenditure or Capital Expenditure under the "Development Activities" Programme, appearing under the Head, "Department of National Budget" specified in the First Schedule, may be transferred subject to guidelines stipulated in Budget Estimates approved by Parliament for the relevant year, to any other Programme under any other Head in that Schedule, by Order of the Secretary to the Treasury or by Order either of a Deputy Secretary to the Treasury or the Director General of the National Budget Department, who may be authorized in that behalf by the Secretary to the Treasury. The money so transferred shall be deemed to be a supplementary allocation made to the particular Ministry, and a report containing the amount of money so transferred and the reasons for the transfer, shall be submitted to Parliament within two months of the date of the said transfer.
- Money allocated to the "Development Activities" Programme may be transferred to any other Programme under any other Head.
- (2) Details of all transfers made under subsection (1), including the reasons for such transfers, shall be incorporated in the reports relating to the Government's fiscal performance, which are required to be tabled in Parliament under the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No.3 of 2003.
 - 7. Where the Minister is satisfied-
 - (a) that receipts from taxes and other sources will be less than the amounts anticipated to finance authorized expenditure; or
- expenditure previously authorized.

Power of Minister to limit

(b) that amounts originally appropriated for a particular purpose or purposes are no longer required,

he may with the approval of the Government, withdraw in whole or in part any amounts previously released for expenditure under the authority of a warrant issued by him, from the Consolidated Fund or from any other fund or moneys of, or at the disposal of the Government, to meet any authorized expenditure and the details of all such withdrawals shall be incorporated in the Final Budget Position Report which is required to be tabled in Parliament under section 13 of the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No. 3 of 2003.

Appropriation Act, No. 7 of 2020

Power of Minister to vary the maximum and minimum limits specified in the Third Schedule to this Act

- **8.** (1) The Minister with the approval of the Government may, on or before May 31, 2022, by Order, vary or alter-
 - (a) any of the maximum limits specified in Column II, Column IV and Column V; and
 - (b) the minimum limits specified in Column III,

of the Third Schedule to this Act.

- (2) No Order made under subsection (1) shall have effect, unless it has been approved by Parliament by Resolution.
- (3) Any Order made under subsection (1) shall, if so expressed therein, be deemed to have had effect from such date prior to the date of making such Order, as may be specified therein.

Power of Parliament to amend the Third Schedule to this Act.

- **9.** Parliament may by Resolution amend the Third Schedule to this Act, by adding to the appropriate Columns of that Schedule any activity and providing for -
 - (a) all or any of the maximum limits relating to such activity;
 - (b) the minimum limit relating to such activity.

Sinhala text to prevail in case of inconsistency.

10. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall prevail.
