2. The persons who, at the time of the coming into operation of this Act, are members of the Ceylon National Association for the Prevention of Tuberculosis (hereinafter referred to as "the association") and such other persons as are hereafter enrolled as members of the association shall be a body corporate (hereinafter referred to as "the corporation") with perpetual succession, a common seal and the name "The Ceylon National Association for the Prevention of Tuberculosis". The corporation may sue and be sued by that name.

6. All debts and liabilities of the Sums payable by or to the existing the at time assosiated to coming into operation of this Act shall be be to the corporation paid and discharged by the corporation, and all debts due to and subscriptions and

Object of the corporation.

3. The object of the corporation shall be to assist in every possible way in the prevention and control of tuberculosis in Sri Lanka.

Seal of the corporation.

4. The affairs of the corporation shall, subject to the rules in force for the time being of the corporation, be administered by the council elected in accordance with such rules.

The corporation—

The corporation may acquire, hold, and dispose of property.

- may acquire and hold any movable (a) or immovable property by right of purchase, grant, gift, testamentary disposition or otherwise,
- shall hold any property subject to the rules for the time being of the corporation, and

8. (1) The corporation may from time Rules. to time, at a special general meeting of the members of which not less than twenty-eight days' notice shall be given to the members and by a majority of votes which shall be not less than two-thirds of the members voting at the meeting, make rules relating to the admission, suspension or expulsion of members, the duties of the officers of the corporation, the procedure in the transaction of business and generally the management of the affairs of the corporation and the accomplishment of its object.
