Cause No. 1.

Cargo handed over to the Crown for the purpose of warehousing.

On hearing the Hon. Mr. Anton Bertram, K.C., Attorney-General, with him Mr. S. Obeyesekere, Crown Counsel, and on considering the motion for an order authorizing the Marshal to make arrangements for the warehousing at Calcutta of all cargo on board the ' Rappenfels ':

It is ordered and decreed that the Marshal be authorized, for the purpose of the warehousing of the cargo, to put the cargo in the hands of the Crown, the Attorney-General undertaking on behalf of the Crown that in the event of the cargo, or any part of it, being for this purpose removed out of the jurisdiction of the Court, it shall be brought back within the jurisdiction upon the order of the Court.
