Mr. Parathalingam objects to this appeal being heard on the ground that it is out of time. Mr. Jayasuriya appearing for the appellant concedes that the appeal is out of time by four days. He however moves that the matter be dealt with in revision. This I am not prepared to do as I do not think the revisionary powers of this Court extend to orders made by Labour Tribunals.

The appeal is rejected with costs.
